

## Pushpa Kamal Dahal 'Prachanda' to become Nepal's next PM with support from Oli-led CPN-UML



In a dramatic turn of events on Sunday, opposition CPN-UML and other smaller parties extended their support to CPN-Maoist Centre chairman Pushpa Kamal Dahal "Prachanda", who is now set to become the next Prime Minister of Nepal.

A crucial meeting of former prime minister KP Sharma Oli-led opposition CPN-UML, CPN-Maoist Centre, Rastriya

Swatantra Party (RSP) and other smaller parties agreed to form a government under the leadership of 'Prachanda'.

The CPN-UML, CPN-MC and other parties are set to stake a claim for Prachanda's premiership at the President's Office 'Sheetalniwas'.

The meeting was attended by Oli, Prachanda, RSP president Ravi Lamichhane, Rastriya Prajatantra Party chief

Rajendra Lingden, Janata Samanwadi Party president Ashok Rai among others at Oli's residence, Balkot.

There has been an understanding between Prachanda and Oli to lead the government on a rotation basis and Oli agreed to make Prachanda Prime Minister at the first chance, as per his demand.

Ganesh Man Singh (November 9, 1915 – September 18, 1997) was the leader of the democratic movement of 1990 in Nepal. He is revered as the Father of Democracy and the Iron-man of Nepali politics. He joined Praja Parishad to protest against the autocratic rule of the Ranas.

Ganesh Man Singh was born on November 9, 1915, in Itum Bahal, Kathmandu. His father was Gyan Man Singh and his mother was Sanunani Shrestha Singh. His father died when he was young, so his grandfather, Ratna Man Singh (who was Badakaji in the Rana regime), raised him. Ganesh Man Singh was one of the main leaders of the Nepali Congress Movement in 2007

B.S., which was able to overthrow the Rana Regime.

In 2015 B.S., he was elected as a Member of Parliament from Kathmandu and later became a Cabinet Minister. After the coup d'état by King Mahendra, Singh became one of the main leaders advocating for democracy in Nepal. He ultimately became the Supreme leader of Nepali Congress, the title he held throughout his life.

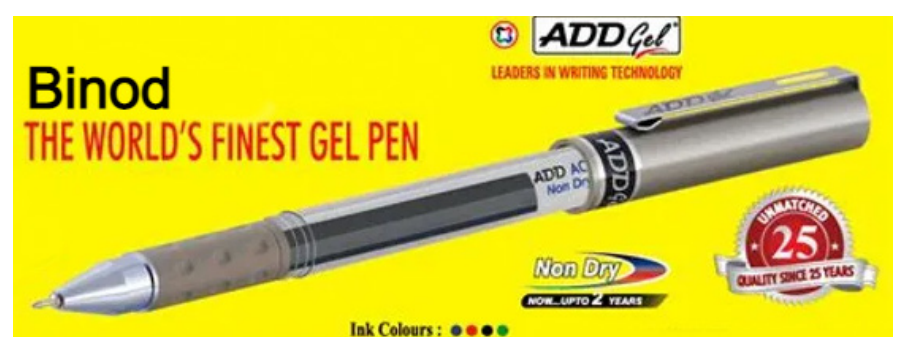
Sushil Prasad Koirala (12 August 1931 – 9 February 2016) was a Nepalese politician and the Prime Minister of Nepal from 11 February 2014 to 10 October 2015. He was also President of the Nepali Congress from 2010 to 2016, having earlier served under various capacities in the party. Koirala was born to Bodh Prasad and Kumudini Koirala on 12 August 1939 in Biratnagar. A member of the politically prominent Koirala Family. Koirala entered politics in 1954 inspired by the social-democratic ideals of the Nepali Congress. In 1958, he keenly participated in Bhadra Abagya Aandalon (Civil Disobedience Movement) launched by the Nepali Congress. In 1959, he actively involved himself in the party's objective of carrying out the democratic elections. The

Nepali Congress emerged as the largest party in the 2013 Constituent Assembly elections under Koirala's leadership. He was elected leader of the Congress' parliamentary party securing 105 out of 194 votes against former prime minister Deuba's 89 votes, and on 10 February 2014, he was nominated as prime minister by the constituent assembly.

A single person is not responsible for these social problems. It is high time to get relief of these undesirable social evils. The personal interesting or to willful one's personal of the people at the cost of others rights, dignity, health, safety, and socio-cultural values can be called Social problems; such as Girl trafficking, forced, smoking in public, gambling, unwilling physical relationship between two individuals of opposite sex, drug misuse, violence, against women, theft, robbery, kidnapping, murder, rape, corruption, drinking alcohol and misbehaving in public places or at home places these are the examples of social problems. Such social problems are greater hindrances to make the peace, well-being, development of our country, security, harmony etc. These problems are too complex to be solved. All the causes of any given problem are too complicated and interrelated to be changed successfully. Problems are embedded in the nature of society. Social problems are the general factors that affect the society. Social problems often involve problems that affect real life. It also affects how people react to certain situations. People practice and promote social evils because they are ignorant of the adversities. There are lots of NGOs and INGOs which are working to eliminate social problems. The awareness programs they introduce do not reach to the actual victims. Social problems represent conditions that should not be allowed to continue because they are perceived to be problems for society, requiring society to react to them and find remedies. We have seen that social problems are 'social' in the sense that they capture public attention. They are more than private troubles, perhaps through reasons of scale but certainly because they are able to connect with other public issues, values and concerns for example, with contemporary concerns about social justice or social order. They are historically and culturally specific – that is, they belong to, or are visible in, particular societies at particular times. Finally, while they may be associated with changing social conditions (a rise or fall in the numbers of people in a particular condition such as poverty or homelessness), their status as social problems depend upon how they are perceived. If, for example, a condition such as homelessness is seen as a matter of individual choice or misfortune, it is unlikely to be viewed as a 'social' problem requiring public attention and action. A process of social construction determines both which issues are defined as social problems and the ways in which they are defined as such.

## Social Problems, its cause and solution in Nepal

Nepal is one of the underdeveloped countries of the world. There are different social problems and evils in the society. Social problems and evils are issues which affect the members of a society. A social problem is normally a term used to describe problems with a particular area or group of people in the world. Some of the common social evils would be alcoholism, racism, child abuse, etc. It also affects how people react to certain situations. Nepal is facing a large number of social problems such as caste system, child labor, illiteracy, gender inequality, superstitions, religious conflicts and much more. A single person is not responsible for these social problems. It is high time to get relief of these undesirable social evils. Illiteracy and poverty are also the major root causes of social evils. Social problems and evils are the barriers to development and progress. 27% of the population is under absolute poverty. Because of poor growth in the agricultural sector, living standards in rural areas causes poverty. The growing population has put heavy pressure on cultivable land. The superstitious beliefs which are deeply rooted in Nepalese societies are also promoting social problems. People believe in various traditions which would not let an individual to progress. This happens because people are innocent. Untouchability was legally prohibited on 2020 BS but it is deep rooted still now. Deuki system is one of the evil social practices or tradition or culture in the hilly area of the far western region, poor people offer their young daughter to the god. Dowry system is the practice in which cash or goods given to bridegroom from the bride's father in the marriage ceremony. There is a belief that grown-up daughters are not supposed to be kept in home for the too long time so their marriage is done in the early age, which causes mental and physical problems and then causes the premature death of the mother.

## POVERTY

There are some essential things which are needed to live such as food, clothes and shelter. We can not live comfortably without having one of them. If somebody does not get to eat a sufficient amount of food or clothes for wearing or place for living is called a poor person or are known to be living in poverty. 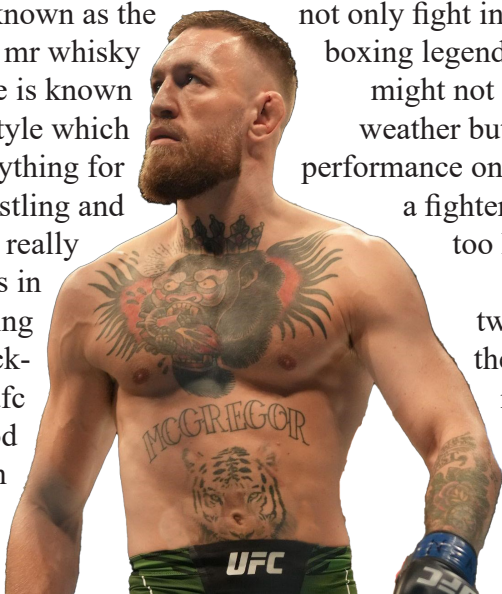

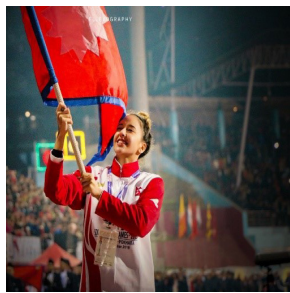

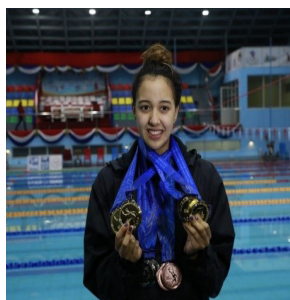
## The pride of Nepal

David Miller is a left-handed batsman, renowned for his power-hitting. He made his debut at the age of 17. Miller made his first-class debut in the Dolphins's finals game of the 2007-2008 domestic super sports series. He went on to score his first half century in the first innings of the game. Miller earned his international call-up in May 2010 after a series for South Africa against Bangladesh where he ended as the second highest run-scorer. He made his Twenty20 international debut for South Africa on 20 May 2010 against the West Indies in Antigua. He was called to replace Jacques Kallis, and went on to become the highest run-scorer of the match. Two days later, Miller made his debut, also against the west indies. On 15 October he made his maiden ODI fifty against Zimbabwe and south Africa went on to put a massive total of 351. In the tour of Sri Lanka in July 2013 where in the 3rd ODI he scored 85 of 72 balls and gave South Africa their first win of the

tour. He made his first ODI century against West Indies in January 2015. His partnership of 256 runs with JP Dummer is the highest fifth wicket partnership in ODI for South Africa. On 6 May 2013, Miller scored the third fastest century in IPL history for Kings XI Punjab. He scored 101 not-out of 38 balls against Royal Challengers Bangalore. He is known for his excellent power-hitting. An excellent fielder, he has become a key member of the South African cricket team.

## ROGER FEDERER RETIREMENT

Tennis legend Roger Federer is retiring from the sport after a 24-year career. The Swiss player made the announcement on 15/09/2022 Thursday.



Watching Roger Federer courtside — a rare privilege — has always been an otherworldly experience. Especially on a hard court, you immediately notice something wholly different about the Swiss.

Federer said the Laver Cup in London next week will be his final ATP event. He has faced multiple injuries and surgeries and said he knows his "body's capacities and limits."

He holds the professional tennis record for the most consecutive weeks at No. 1 with 237, and the record for the oldest player to rank No. 1, at 36, in 2018. The 41-year-old is a 20-time Grand Slam champion. He has played more than 1,500 matches during which the ATP records that he served 11,478 aces.

"Tennis has treated me more generously than I ever would have dreamt, and now I must recognize when it is time to end my competitive career," Federer read. "I will play more tennis, of course, but just not in Grand Slams or on the tour."

His one-handed backhand was a throwback, but a modern take. He could roll it topspin, knife a low, skidding slice, and flick it at short angle, and carve it with sidespin.

Federer turned pro as a teenager and established storied rivalries against fellow tennis legends Rafael Nadal and Novak Djokovic.

He thanked his wife Mirka, his parents, his sister and his business team in the emotional letter. Federer recorded more than \$130 million in career earnings. His sponsors include Wilson, Rolex, Mercedes-Benz, Uniqlo, Moët Hennessey, and Credit Suisse.

At the U.S. Open in late August, he referenced the possibility of his retirement, saying it was "almost time to retire — but not yet." Afterwards, he walked that comment back as "a total joke."

Federer did not say what he was planning to do after retiring from the tour, but he concluded the letter, writing: "Finally, to the game of tennis: I love you and will never leave you."

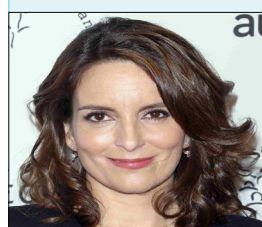
## WHAT IS BEAUTY?

If you retain nothing else, always remember the most important rule of beauty, which is: who cares?"



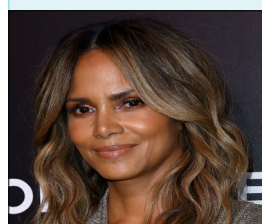
Mindy Kaling (American actress and producer) says:

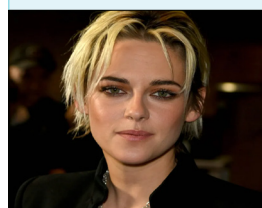
Penelope Cruz (Spanish actress) says:

A Trip to Manakamana

The Manakamana temple and the small village just nearby attract pilgrims from all over Asia and beyond. The temple stands on the top of a 1300 meters high hill located at Mugling. Mugling is 106 km to the west of Kathmandu, which means you can reach there after about a 3 hour bus ride. Before, one had to walk to the temple. Of course, the beautiful villages, orchards and the simple village life enthralled everyone on the way. But the journey was exhausting. Reaching the Manakamana temple is a lot easier these days . Thanks to the cable cars, or rather the Manakamana Cable Cars. After a 15 minute exhilarating ride across a river and two ridges, you reach the Manakamana temple, the house of the wish-fulfilling God. It is where you can hear ringing bells and chants and

prayers all day long. The incense sticks impart a sweet smell into the cool breeze. And unfortunately but true, hundreds of devotees sacrifice goats and other animals behind the temple. There's a lot more you can do at Manakamana. You can tour the village just nearby and visit the ancient durbar (a king's palace) that dates back to the 17th century. You can spend the night at the village where there are a couple of good lodges. Most people prefer to walk down the hill on their return journey, but the cable car can also bring you back to Chereng, just 5 km east of Mugling. There are many reasons for visiting this temple. Many married couples come here to worship for their long life together, students for their success in their studies, businessman for the success in their business and so on.

It has become the best spot for the trek lovers from Gorkha Bazar. The easiest means to reach the temple or the best solution to reach there is by cable car which is very useful and comfortable way to reach the temple on time. Cable car carries six people at a time and takes 8 minutes to reach to the other end. The view seen from the cable car is very entertaining. The Bizarre Relationship of The Vampire Ground Finch & The Nazca booby

we first start with taking about the Vampire ground finch. The vampire ground finch is a small bird native to the Galápagos Islands. The Nazca booby is a large seabird of the booby family, Sulidae, native to the eastern Pacific. First described by Walter Rothschild in 1902, it was long considered a subspecies of the masked booby until recognized as distinct genetically and behavior-

ally in 2002. It has a typical sulid body shape, with a long-pointed orange-yellow bill, long neck, aerodynamic body, long slender wings and pointed tail. The adult is bright white with black and white wings, a black tail and a dark face mask. The unusual thing about the vampire finch and the booby is that when alternative sources are scarce the vampire finch occasionally feeds by drink-

ing the blood of other birds, chiefly the Nazca boobies by pecking at their skin with their sharp beaks until blood is drawn., Curiously, the boobies do not offer much resistance against this. It has been theorized that this behavior evolved from the pecking behavior that the finch used to clean parasites from the plumage of the booby.

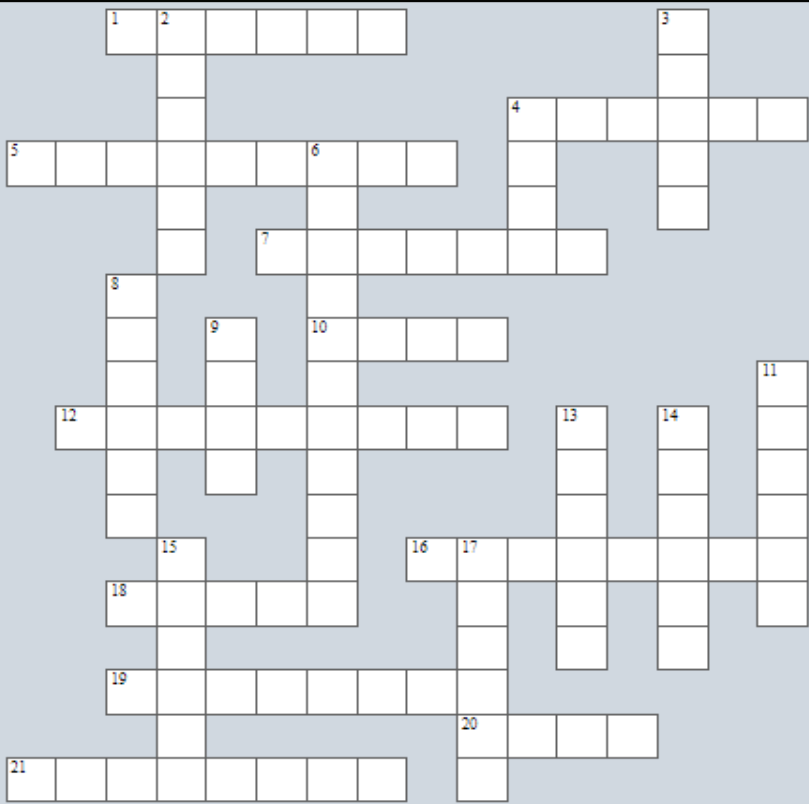
My Trip To Jomsom

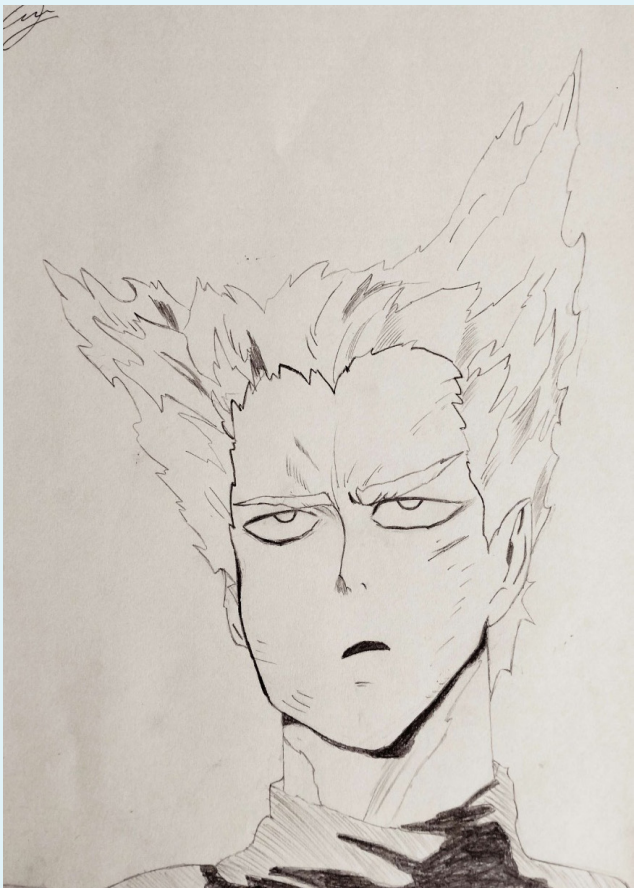

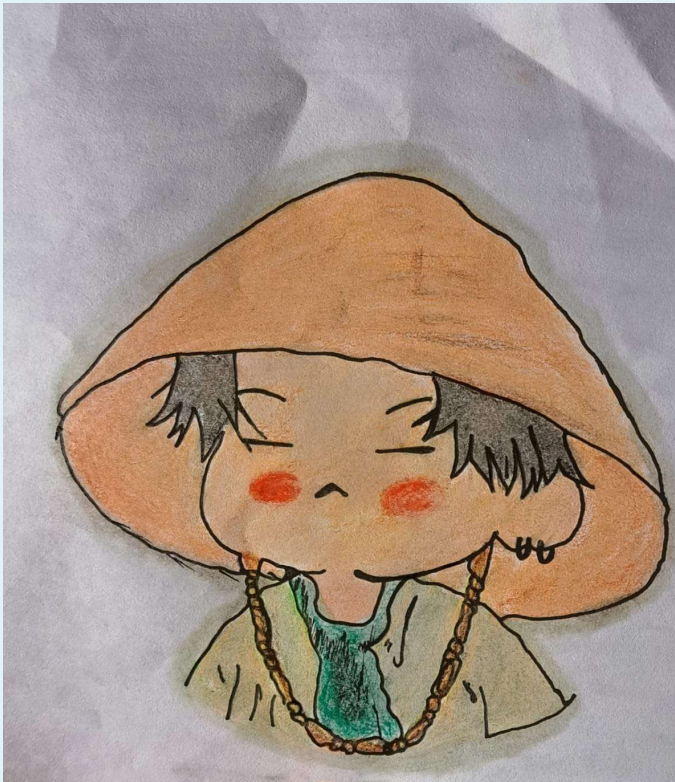
